Out of 9 participants 4 blind and low vision won medals in different categories. Sakuntla Sahu got an opportunity to participate in **IBSA Judo World Cup Asian, Antalya, Turkey** which was going to be scheduled on 19<sup>th</sup> April to 20<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

### Sakuntla's Story.....

Sakuntla Verma 23 years old and totally blind lives in tarsiva Village, Tilda block belongs to very poor family. She lives with her mother and two brothers. She study till class 2<sup>nd</sup> her parents were not able to teach her due to financial problem. In order to support her family her mother use to manage one pan shop but she was not able to continue shop for long.

In the year 2016 Grihini team met with Sakuntla Verma and then she got information related to government schemes, rights of Person with disabilities. Sightsavers and Grihini organize training to empower girls through Self-defence training for visual impaired girls in which she took active participation and know different techniques personal safety.



She got selected for **5<sup>th</sup> National level Para Judo championship 2017, Haryana and won Silver Medal in 63 kg Senior Category** Again in November 2017 she went to Bilaspur for state level judo selection competition and she got selected for **6<sup>th</sup> National Blind and deaf Judo championship 2018**.

After that She participate in 5 day judo training for blind and low vision girls which was organized by Sightsavers and Grihini in December 2017 in which she kept on practicing for National level Judo championship and also **won Silver medal in 78 kg senior category in 6th National Blind and deaf Judo championship 2018, Lucknow**. District Magistrate, Balodabazar, Chhattisgarh honoured her and told Sakuntla to take part in upcoming National and International level judo championship. Now Sakuntla got an opportunity to participate in **IBSA Judo World Cup Asian, Antalya, Turkey** which was going to schedule on 19<sup>th</sup> April to 20<sup>th</sup> April 2018.



## **Malti's Journey to New World .....**

Kumari Malti Sahu (21) lives with her father, mother and two brother and one sister in Kakri village of Balodabazar block. She belongs to marginal family her two brothers are eldest among all siblings. Her mother and father work as labour and her brother leaves separately after getting married.

Since birth she was blind but she continue her study till class 3<sup>rd</sup> in village primary school after her parents are facing difficulty in sending her to nearby school which is 1 km away from her house they are not getting any associate for her who drop her school daily.

Grihini met with Kumari Malti Sahu on 3<sup>rd</sup> march 2016 she came to know about rights and entitlements of PWDs and government schemes for PWDs. She share her story with Grihini team that how she was being tortured by her family member every time because she is blind at that time she was frustrated with her life. After she came in came to know about Sightsavers CG social inclusion program she took lead to form



SHG of 7 person and named it as Jai Sidh Baba Divyang Self Help Group in which she is appointed as president this was turning point in Malti's life. SHG members use to conduct meeting and saving on monthly basis and to support their SHG financially MLA also gave Rs. 2000. In the year 2017 she enrolls herself in exact foundation dandesara for learning Braille.

In the span of 1 year she took active participation in various training and activity like Daily living skill training ,TOT leadership training, Half marathon, *Self-defense* training for blind and low vision girls which organized by Sightsavers after attaining this type of training her confidence boost up. Malti got opportunity from Sightsavers to take part in Judo training which was organized in Bilaspur where she learnt different techniques of Judo, Malti found it very interesting and ask Grihini team to guide her in upcoming days, so that she can achieve her goal. She kept on practicing Judo which was organized by Sightsavers and Malti got selected for 5<sup>th</sup> **National Judo Blind and Deaf Paralympic Judo 2017 Haryana, Gurgram** and took part in **53kg senior category and won bronze medal. Mr. Rajesh Singh Rana, District Magistrate, Balodabazar, Chhattisgarh honored her and gave her cash prize Rs. 7000** and motivate her to take part in upcoming Judo championship.

On 26<sup>th</sup> January 2017 she was honored in her Gram Panchayat in which cash prize of Rs.500 was given to her for winning bronze medal in judo championship.

In December 2017 on the occasion of world disability day sightsavers organized 5 day judo training for blind and low vision girls in which she got selected for **6<sup>th</sup> National Blind and deaf Judo championship 2018, Lucknow in senior category 55 kg.**

At present she is capable to do everything by herself she don't need assistant for her day to day activity. Now Malti is giving self-defence training to teenager girls in **anganwadi** every Saturday so that girls can protect themselves.



## Jagaswari's Story....

Jagaswari Verma (22) resides with her father mother and two elder brother in Devri village of balodabazar block. She belongs to middle class family unfortunately Jagaswari is blind since her birth. Her family is having 4acr of agriculture land and they totally depended on Rainfed agriculture hence there in no sufficient productivity it is very difficult for her parent to fulfill their family need, that's why her father and brother work as labour to support their family financially. Her parents were illiterate due to lack of knowledge they didn't enroll Jagaswari in school.

In the year 2016 Grihini team met with Jagaswari and then she got information related to government schemes, rights of Person with disabilities and also know about SHG and its benefit.

In the year 2016 sightsavers came up with new concept to empower girls through Self defense training for visual impaired girls in which she took active participation and know different techniques personal safety. Jagaswari attain JUDO training which was organized by sightsavers in Bilaspur and was selected for **5<sup>th</sup> National Judo Blind and Deaf Paralympic Judo 2017 Haryana, Gurgram** and took part in **44 kg senior** category and **won Bronze medal**, after that **Mr. Rajesh Singh Rana, District Magistrate, Balodabazar, Chhattisgarh honored her and gave her cash prize Rs. 7000** and motivate her to take part in upcoming Judo championship. On **26<sup>th</sup> January 2017 she was honored in her Gram Panchayat in which cash prize of Rs.500** was given to her for wining bronze medal.



Jagaswari also got **7<sup>th</sup> position in Raipur Half Marathon, 2017** and received cash prize Rs. 5000, On the occasion of International women's day Jagaswari was honored by **Chhattisgarh state commission for women.**

After that she kept on practicing in Judo training which was organized by sightsavers and got selected for **6<sup>th</sup> National Blind and Deaf Judo Championship 2018, Lucknow** in junior category 44 kg.

Apart from this Jagaswari engaged herself in giving training to 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> standard girls every Saturday in nearby village paragaon, saloni and also train girls in anganwadi center on every Wednesday. She told that now she is living better dignified life and want to motivate visually impaired and other girls.



### **Half Marathon**

Half Marathon 2018 was organized by Sports and Youth Welfare in New Raipur on 11th February 2018. In this marathon, the runners from the entire India participated with the national and international level runners, including students of the state youth, school-college student. There is also special categories available for females and senior citizens 21 kms, 10 kms, 5 kms, 03 kms for tricycle race, 1 km for blind and low vision person . International athletic Padmashree PT Usha were also present on the occasion as well as coach of Indian athletic team GS Bhatia for the enthusiasm of the runners. And from Balodabazar district Sigma, Palari, Bhatapara, Balodabazar 60 participants registered their name online to Half Marathon we portal with support of grihini team. And from Balodabazar 5 PWD's won tricycle race and blind race for them Sports and Youth Welfare announce cash prize.
