Case study: Shaping Towards Enterprise

In the year 2014 survey was conducted in Sigma block of Balodabazar district for SHG formation for disable person under “CG social Inclusion Program” under this program Saviti Yadu and Sangita Markandaey attain training for formation of SHG. After that they share all the information to other disable women. Then Jankini Sahu has taken lead to form SHG in which she want to include disabled women in that Self Help Group and she start motivating other women to join their group.

In the year 2015 a small group of women started their Self Help Group called “BIHINI” in which all the member are orthopaedic and They start doing meeting every month and decided to collect Rs 100 every month as saving. Member decided to start stitching enterprise to earn their livelihood.

Under CG social Inclusion program BIHINI SHG member attain advance stitching training after getting advance stitching training they start stitching more designer cloths and income of their enterprise increase. They also start doing market linkage in nearby market apart from stitching designer cloths members are also engaged in stitching bags, hand bag. BAHINI SHG also open bank account in State Bank of India.

Under CG social Inclusion program Sightsavers visit their SHG and guide them so that they can run their enterprise smoothly. Business plan was also made by one of the Sightsavers partner *BASIX* for BAHINI SHG stitching enterprise, So that they can expand their enterprise in large scale and earn more profit. In order to expand their Stitching enterprise exposer visit was also organized in Devangan House, Kharora and Sumeet Synfab India Pvt. Ltd., Raipur so that they can learn how manage enterprise, learn about latest technology of garment industry and marketing strategies. After this exposure visit BIHINI SHG receive tender from Devangan House, Kharora for stitching petticoat and now they are doing well. Apart from this this are also stitching blouse and petticoat. At present they are BAHINI SHG is earning Rs19,500 monthly.

In future BAHINI SHG is planning to open one stitching training centre to teach other Disabled women and non-disabled women of nearby village. They also submit application to government for sanitary napkin, for tender of government school uniform .The group currently has earning Rs 19,000 per month.
