7th National blind and deaf Judo Championship 2019

Date 18 January to 22 January 2019 , Place Gorakhpur, UP

5 day national blind and deaf judo championship 2019 was organized in Gorakhpur, UP from 18 January to 22 January 2019 organized by Blind and deaf para association, Gorakhpur. Inauguration of judo championship 2019 was done by Mr. Amit Gupta, commissioner by lightning of lamp. In this Judo championship 700 participants from 15 states across India took part.

Again this year from Chhattisgarh 43 players took active participation and with support of Grihini 7 (Male- 2, Female- 5) players also participated form Balodabazar in blind and deaf judo championship 2019. Urmila Yadav junior category 40 kg, Manjula Khosle senior category 45 kg, Jagashwari verma category Senior 45 kg, Malti Sahu senior category 50 kg, sakuntla Sahu senior category 66 kg , Nehru Verma senior category 60 kg, Komal Verma senior category 81 kg. They also perform very well in different category of judo and sakuntla Sahu won silver medal in senior category 66 kg.

Team Chhattisgarh won total 13 medal in which 7 silver and 6 Bronze medal and from Grihini Sakuntala Sahu won silver medal in senior category 66 kg.

At the end national blind and deaf Judo championship 2019 prize distribution was done followed by National Anthem and thanks giving by officials blind and para association of India.



NRLM SARAS Mela

The SARAS Fair 2019 had over 150 stalls that showcased a number of traditional arts and craft items produced by rural poor SHG women, as also a number of products which have added value to the farm and non-farm produce of these women.

The stalls display exclusive product such as skills, potential and hard work of Women and PWDs from across India. The products ranges from handlooms, handicrafts, artefacts and heritage products, tribal ornaments, decorative items, metallic products, earthen utensils, paintings, organic food items, spices, processed food products, soft toys. Main objective of this Fair is to provide to the rural women producers a national platform and an opportunity to showcase their products, and seek buyers, either individuals or bulk buyers for sale nationally

In this fair 2 SHG Ujjwal Grihini SHG and Ekta Divyang SHG nominated by NRLM with support of Grihini to sell their product in SARAS Fair which was organized at Raipur and Bhilai and sold Agarbatti, phenyl, door mat, cloth bags, and silk thread bangles. Group earn profit of Rs 2500 during this SARAS Fair.



Enabling environment

Post access audit workshop and various advocacy by DPO and Grihini regularly results in creating barrier free environment for physically challenged person. DM took this initiative and form access audit committee in Balodabazar, district which consist of 5 member and for this they have appointed one DPO leader in access audit committee. In first phase committee will do access audit of District Collectorate building, Zila Panchayat, District Hospital, Municipality building etc. On the basis of this access audit report they will provide facilities to government building which is necessary for vulnerable groups.

Succseze Story

Tekram (28), an independent man with disability residing in Damru Village, Balodabazar with his parents and 3 siblings. His parents every year migrate to other places in search of livelihood opportunity. Tekram use to live with his grandmother when his parents migrate to other place. Belongs to middle class family and due to financial problem and lack of education facility in village leads him to left scholl after 10th standard.

In the year 2016 he came in touch with Grihini associate and know about Sightsavers CG social inclusion program and understood about person with disabilities rights and entitlements. He attain various Skill development training, leadership and capacity building training. Grihini associate also share the concept of Person with Disabilities Self-help group and then he took initiative to form Self Help Group in his village and named it as Divyang Jan Kalyan Sabal Samhu and slowly they start saving money in their group so that in future they can start any livelihood activity.

He stated that he never wanted his family to feel burden because of taking care of him so he decided to start tailoring work at his home and earn approximately Rs 2000 per month but he has vision to expand his tailoring work further to expand his tailoring work he did advocacy on behalf of his Self Help Group to Gram Panchayat asking for allotment of shop for PWDs SHG. Now shop is allotted by Gram panchayat to SHG and now He is doing tailoring work in that shop and earing Rs 5000 to Rs 6000 per month. He believe that earning from shop will help him fulfil his family dream. His effort and will to become economically independent is appreciated by family and other village.
