Article 5: Equality and non-discrimination, Article 9: Accessibility, Article 13: Access to Justice, Article 12: Equal recognition before the law, Article 11: Freedom to live, Article 24: Right to Education, Article 25: Right to access medicals, Article 27: Education, Article 34: Reservation.
