**Exposer visit of Person with Disability Self-help group on phynle and detergent powder making**

Date: 17 to 18 July 2019 , Veauue : Nividita foundation, Champa

A two day exposure visit on phynle and detergent powder visit organized by Grihini with support of Sightsavers at Nividita foundation, Chapa. In which 21 participants from 10 PWDs SHGs took part. Main objective of this training is to aware SHGs member to improve quality of their product by minimizing cost of product and also to compete with market

Session start with introduction of participants and facilitator. Facilator Mrs Shipra Devi told what their SHG are doing and how they are doing management of livelihood activity. After that participants went to kono village where Kamana SHG are engaged in making phynle where SHG members also describe process of making phynle and what ingredient they are using to prepare good quality of phynle also demonstrate step by step process. Kamana SHG member also told that in order to attract more and more customer they are using different flavour. At last they also demonstrate participants how they



are doing packaging and labelling of product in order to compete with current market. Kamana SHG also discuss on strategies they adopt to do marketing of phynle. SHG members mention that packaging play a very important role in order to attract more customer as they said in starting they sold product without any brand name at that time they are facing trouble in attracting customer but now they are selling products under brand name with attractive packaging now they are able to attract more customer.

Next day participants went to aurekera village and intracted with Sangrash SHG who are engaged in making Hand wash liquid. SHG member told what ingredients they are using to prepare hand wash and they told they are selling product in local market. Then after participants went to sakripali and interacted with Hari Mahila SHG who are engaged in making detergent powder. they also demonstrate process and ingredient of washing powder one by one. Members of SHG told how they are managing their group activity. And also mention that each and every member are assigned responsibility which they must have to perform. SHG members also discuss on costing and profit, packaging, and marketing etc .They also told all participants that how they are minimizing cost without compromising in quality.

This was followed by thanks giving and participants also share their learnings from exposure visit in which they part they are lacking and they also told that by implementing all those idea what they have learned will help them in making good quality product.



## Livelihood intervention sharing workshop with government department

Date: 23 July,

Venue: Pragati hall Balodabazar

Grihini with support of Sightsavers organize one day workshop on Livelihood for the person with disability in collaboration with Social welfare department at Pragati Hall, collectorate building, Balodabazar. The main objective of this workshop is to aware all the government department which are directly or indirectly linked with person with disability for their betterment. Total 150 participants took part including government staff and DPO leaders and beneficiary from balodabazar district.

Session start with floral welcoming of Mr. Jogendra Nayak , Upper collector, Balodabazar, Mr. Asutosh Panday CEO balodabazar, Mrs Asha Shukla Director, Social welfare department and other government official. Then Mrs. Rupa Srivastava, Director gave a brief presentation of what Grihini and Sightsavers are doing under “CG social inclusion program”. And describe what Grihini and is doing for PWDs of Balodabazar district in four block sigma, palari, bhatapara, balodabazar.

In addition this Director Grihini focus on objective such as economic empowerment, rights and entitlements, accessible environment. Then she also describe how organization is empowering PWDs at state, district, block level by organizing different training, workshop on livelihood, leadership and capacity building training, Sustainable development goals etc and how it affect Persons with disabilities to enhanced their quality of life. Mrs. Rupa Srivastava then describe block wise SHG details through graphic presentation in which she also mention that weather SHG were linked with NRLM and suggest NRLM official to register active PWDs SHG in NRLM so that they can get RF, CIF and start their livelihood activity, In addition to this Upper collector also asked NRLM officials to register active PWDs SHG of Grihini in NRLM. In next slide Grihini director focus on livelihood activity which are carried out by PWDs SHG of balodabazar and told that most of the SHGs are engaged in Aagarbati making, stitching, phynle making, detergent making, market tax collection and they are doing well in this trades. In next slide Grihini Director discuss on few expectation of SHGs from different government department

Register PWDs SHGs in NRLM and give them preference in getting RF and CIF.

To provide outlet to SHGs from government so that SHGs can sell their product which is prepared by them.

Giving preference to PWDs beneficiary in distribution of chicks and goat from Animal Husbandry department.

Provide skill development training to PWDs according to their disability

Preference to be given to PWDs SHGs for Market tax collection.

Preference to be given to PWDs SHGs for Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.

Preference to be given to PWDs SHGs from Women and child development department for making ready to eat food and mid-day meal.



To provide divyang mitra in all government department.

In addition to this Mr. Jogendra Nayak Upper collector gave instruction to skill development department, baldabazar officials to identify trades according to disability and also told Skill development department officials to give them preference. Mr. Asutosh Panday CEO balodabazar instruct all department to make accessible environment for person with disability so that they can easily access to their rights and entitlements. This was followed by presentation of RPWD act 2016 by Mr. Ghyanshyam sahu, president, Jan manav viklang kalyan sangh, Balodabazar in which he focus on few important points such as education, skill development and employment, social security, health, Rehabilitation and recreation, central and state advisory board on disability and district level committee, special court, offences and penalties, state fund for person with disability. This was followed recognition given to state level wheel chair cricket players by Mr. Jogendra Nayak, Upper collector to tilak nishad, Tamil dhruv, purshottam sah for their good performance.





## District Block Level Meeting

DPO submit application to Chief minister of Chhattisgarh to implement all the amendment in state as per RPWDs Act 2016 which are under state such as education for providing inclusive education to the children with disabilities without any discrimination, *skill development and employment* for this Government shall formulate schemes and programmes including provision of loans at concessional rates to facilitate and support employment of persons with disabilities especially for their vocational training and self-employment, Social security, Health, rehabilitation and recreation for this government shall formulate necessary schemes and programmes to safeguard and promote the right of persons with disabilities for adequate standard of living to enable them to live independently or in the community, central and state advisory board on disability and district level committee. So that it will help PWD to enjoy the right to equality, life with dignity, and respect for his or her own integrity equally with others.
