Entrepreneurship training

No of Participants: Male: 8 Female: 17 Total: 25

Three day training entrepreneurship training was organized by Grihini with support of Sightsavers for Person with disability SHG members in which 25 PWDs took active participation. The training programme commence with introduction of participants and resource persons Mrs Nidhi Sen, entrepreneurship development officer, CYDA. Then she share the design of the training, its objectives to SHGs members. She also Qexplain what are the different activity such as Sindoor Making, Packaging of Masalla. Rakhi making, making of Paper bags, candle making, gulal making, silk thread bangles/ necklacs set, hair bends, clips, bandhanwar making that can be done by PWDs in group with minimum investment.

Then Trainer demonstrate Self Help Group members how to make Silk thread Bangles by using old bangles then one by one each members try to make Silk thread Bangles and also put decorative item such as stone, pearl .Trainer also demonstrate how to do packaging of Silk thread bangles.

Second day started with demonstration of preparing worship plate, bandhanwar making rakhi making by using waste velvet cloth, gift paper, stones etc. after that every participants one by one try to prepare rakhi and also put decorative items in order to make rakhi attractive. In next session trainer step by step demonstrate how to make gulal, sindoor by arrowroot and also teach them how to do attractive packaging. Then after participants also try to prepare worship plates, rakhi, gulal, sindoor.

On day third trainer did inspection of product which was prepared by participants and she also suggest how to improve the quality, finishing of product so that it will attract customer easily.

At last she demonstrate participates for making flowerpot by using waste cloth, cement then after participants also try to prepare flowerpot trainer also told that flowerpot can be used for home decoration.

At last trainer aware person with disability that all this Seasonal/Micro Business require less investment. She also suggest person with disability members to fancy store in their group, also suggest SHG members that before starting any activity they must know market demand, identify store from where they can by raw material at good price.

At the end of the training program a group photo was taken. This was followed by vote of thanks.



Regional symposium on social marketing and exhibition of products developed by SHGs of PwDs”

Regional symposium on social marketing and exhibition of products developed by SHGs of PwDs” was jointly organized by JSLPS & Sightsavers on 17th of May 2018 at Ranchi Press club. The objective of the programme was to promote Social Marketing, exhibition and sale of products produced by Self-Help Group (SHGs) of persons with disabilities (both exclusive and inclusive). SHGs of Person with disability from different parts of Jharkhand, Bihar, Odisha, West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh participated and showcased their handmade products. More than 78 person with disability participated with a total of 20 stalls for showcasing their products. In which from Balodabazar district 4 SHGs 6 members took participation and showcase their product in stall such as flavoured tea leaf, agarbati, masala and spices, cloth bags, silk thread bangles, worship plates, designer salwar suits, blouse etc

The formal inauguration of the symposium and exhibition was done by guests and delegates with lightning of lamp. Mr. Paritosh Upadhyay, Special Secretary, Govt. Of Jharkhand cum CEO, JSLPS, Dr. Caroline Harper, Global CEO, Sightsavers, Mr. Satish Chandra, State Disability Commissioner, Mr. R. N. Mohanty, CEO, Sightsavers India, Mr. Bishnu C. Parida, COO, JSLPS were present in the symposium and guided the participants how to transform their lives. They made them aware about several Government projects, pension schemes and reservation for PwDs.

The major thrust of the symposium was on “transforming lives of persons with disabilities through promoting livelihoods and strengthening their community based institutions based on both exclusive and inclusive concept of social mobilizations.

Then after the interaction session a poster was released and distributed containing 10 principles of SHG including regular meeting, saving for future, inter-loaning, timely re-payment of loan etc.

“You people can do anything; you have that skills and ability to change your life”. Said- CEO (Global) Sightsavers, Dr. Caroline Harper.

The technical & Interaction session on problem based solution was taken by the resource person Sri Braja Sundar mishra and Srimanta Kr Patra, SPM,SM&IB JSLPS. In this session participants shared their experience and discussed about the solution for their problem. They discussed how to select right product for manufacturing & how to get good market for their product so that they may get good profit.



EU orientation program and State level DPO meeting

Sightsavers organized a one day orientation programme on the EU project at SAMETI, Indira Gandhi Agricultural University Campus, Raipur on 8 th May, 2018. Disabled people’s Organizations members attended the meeting from 3 districts of Chhattisgarh spread across 8 blocks. 49 participants (17 Female and 32Male) from the DPOs, State Disability network members and staff from Samerth and Grihini participated. Session start with introduction of participants followed by presentation of EU project main objectives, activities, strategy and methodology by Mr. Ravi Shankar Behera, Programme Manager. He said that they will work in 5 state Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha and Rajasthan in India and will work with 15 DPOs to empower disabled people’s organization. Then after Mr. Prasanna Kumar, Director, Sightsavers and Mr. Ravi Shankar Behera, Programme Manager Sightsavers both explain why and how they have identified these 15 disabled people’s organization.

At last DPOs leader share what are the different problem face by them while doing advocacy for their rights and entitlements at block, district and state level. After that task is given DPOs to prioritize the advocacy agenda for the next three years and also to identify the important stakeholder and their duty and responsibility for disabled person. At the end of orientation program a group photo was taken. This was followed by vote of the thanks.



Person with disability awareness rally...

On 28.05.2018 District level disabled person organization organize one day awareness rally in Palari block in which 100 PWDs from different village of palari, sigma, bhatapara, balodabazar were present. By organizing this awareness rally disabled person organization wants to sensitize government department officials, community members about person with disability rights.

The awareness rally was started for Gayatri mandir to Janpad Panchayat, Palari Block. Through this awareness rally disabled person did advocacy with Janpad CEO demanding for increasing pension amount of person with disability from Rs 350 to Rs1000 per month, distribution of motorised tricycle, provide training under skill development mission, provide job card and also assigned job according to eligibility, green rashan card, for providing concession while traveling in public and private transport.



Success story of satyam grihini divyang SHG, puraina khapari

Satyam Grihini Divyang SHG is at village purana khapri block Balodabazar. The group was formed in the year 2017 with a membership of 10 person with disabilities in which 6 members are women and 4 members are male. The Person were informed about the process of group formation and the benefits that would arise from such group formation. The primary purpose of self-help groups is to improve the socio-economic condition of disabled person, especially to increase their income.

Observing their interest for formation of a SHG to develop their socio-economic condition the Grihini associate took initiative in formation of the group. All the members decided to conduct a meeting of SHG, every month and decided that each member would deposit an amount of 100/- per month. They also opened their bank account and at present there saving in bank is Rs 10,000.

After that group decided to do livelihood activity in their group then they submit an application to Gram Panchayat on 25.01.2018 and mention that they wanted to do fishery for that they need pond name kalyan sagar. Then after next month again Satyam Grihini Divyang SHG also submit application to district magistrate of balodabazar regarding lease of kalyan Sagar Pond for fishery after that officials from fishery department visit SHG for inspection and mention that to start fishery at least three member name must be in the 2002 survey list and they must belong fisherman family, he told that they will also organize training for members of Satyam Grihini Divyang self-help group, so that they will start fishery in proper manner and earn their livelihood.

Nehru Verma 26 Year old boy from devsundra Village of Palari Block belongs to very poor family. He studied till class 10 and after that he was not able to continue his further study because his family financial condition is not good then he decided to support his family financially he start working as daily wage labour. Unfortunately in year 2012 he is suffering from headache regularly even after treatment by the doctors, there was no improvement in his condition and slowly Nehru's eyesight started diminishing. After this incidence Nehru's mentality began to get distracted. He would remain cut off from the rest of the village.

In 2015, Block coordinator from Grihini, Sightsavers' local partner, approached him and somehow convinced him to join a Self-Help Group named "Bala ji Divyang SHG".

Nehru was trained for leadership, goatery, smart cane, capacity Building training,./roap making, judo by Sightsavers. After this training he start taking active participation in Judo and took part in state, national judo championship. Recently he took part in 6th national judo championship, Lucknow, UP and he perform very well in championship.

Apart from this he was also engaged in goatery to earn his livelihood. It was found that now he is self-dependent and also motivate other person with disabilities. He feels extremely grateful to Grihini and Sightsavers for their support.
