Story of Success

Champa (22) an independent women with disability residing in Tarashiv village of Balodabazar district narrated her journey of becoming an earner from a learner. She lives with her parents and two siblings, belongs to very poor family her Parents use to migrate to other place in search of livelihood. Due to financial problem and lack of awareness among her parents about education leads her to left her study after class 10th and hence she was not able to continue her further study. Being Locomotor she face difficulty in her early life but she always try overcome all the barrier. She wish to be independent and support her family financially. She stated that she 'never wanted her family to feel burden because of taking care of her'. In the year 2017 she came in touch with Grihini associate and know about Sightsavers CG social inclusion program and



understand the concept of Person with Disabilities Self-help group and took initiative to form Self Help Group in her village and she form “*Saksham Grihini Divyang SHG*”. In order to support her family financially she showed her interest in stitching. She engaged herself in stitching during her free time and earn Rs 100 to Rs 150 per day. She came to know about skill training on cutting and tailoring then she immediately enroll her name with Grihini associate for skill training. Where she learn different techniques of stitch designer cloths, bags, doormat. After getting skill training on cutting and tailoring she decided to start tailoring work at her home and start stitching cloths, cloth bags, doormat, slowly start taking order form her village and nearby village on continuous basis.

Champa and member of “*Saksham Grihini Divyang SHG*” decided to start tailoring work in there group. Today Champa is running a stitching corner in her house with her SHG members having five sewing machine. They also trained unemployed young girl of village so that they can also earn their livelihood by doing tailoring work. Till now they trained 6 young girls of village. At present she is earning approximately Rs 250 to Rs 300 per day.

Now she is planning to expand their SHG tailoring work so that they can get order from big market players. Champa told that after getting in touch with Grihini associate her life totally change. She said now in her village prospective of people change about PWDs now they know capabilities of PWDs and start supporting them. Her effort and will to become economically independent is appreciated by her family and by the women in her village.



Two days training workshop on leadership and advocacy

A two day (28.11.2018 to 29.11.2018) training workshop on ' leadership and advocacy was organized by Sightsavers at Sameti Bhawan, Indra Gandhi agriculture university, Raipur, CG. In which 35 Disabled Person organization leaders from 10 districts took part. The training programme commence with introduction of

participants and resource person Mr. Shyam Bohre, retire professor, administrative academy, Bhopal. Resource person share the major objective of training program and then explain advocacy in simple word and how Disabled Person organization can do advocacy for their rights and entitlements at different level for different issue.

Resource person said in order to do advocacy Disabled Person organization (DPO) play a very vital role because without unity no one can achieve their aim. He also highlights quality of good DPO leaders. Mr. Shyam said person with disabilities must know in details about their rights and entitlements before doing advocacy for anything. Then he also focus on method of doing effective advocacy for different public and private departments.

Then DPO leader also share about their achievement and barrier they face by them during time of advocacy. Mr. Shyam appreciate DPO for their achievement and said that do not get frustrated when they are not getting result and suggest DPOs to try to come together every time for advocacy. He said that after several attempt if they are not getting any result then they can opt for RTI. Mr Shyam also discuss about Right to Information for PWDs and explain the process of RTI, how and where PWDs can use RTI. After that he explain that by using RTI they can find out details of government work, RTI can be used to know how much fund is allocated for PWDs by using data PWDs can protest for their fund. He also demonstrate PWDs how to write application for RTI. At last Mr. Shyam told DPO leader must take part in Gram Sabha, aware them about their problem face by PWDs and do fact based advocacy so that every PWDs get benefited and live better life.

At the end of the training program a group photo was taken. This was followed by vote of thanks.
