World Sight Day 2019

On the occasion of world sight day 2019 with support of Sightsavers, Grihini organize Free Check-up and awareness campaign for person with disability on 12 October 2019 in collaboration with health department at cherkadhi ,Palri. The camp was organized for the first time in this area, where the people were unaware of their eye problems for lack of resources and facilities. In this total 141 (81 male and 60 female) people got their eye checked. Program commence with welcoming of Dr. Nirala, BMO , Dr Sukanti Sona, eye specialist, Dr. Roshan, optometrist and all participants. This was followed by Introduction of Organization and CG social inclusion program objective. This was followed by Introduction of Organization and CG social inclusion program objective. to protect your eyes from a variety of ailments. This rise in air pollution can often lead irritating and vicious eye irritation leading to redness of the eyes, watery eyes

and burning sensation. In order to ensure adequate eye care they must keep in their mind some important things such as avoid rubbing eyes even if particulates enter them, wash eyes thoroughly with water, apply a cool compress to help reduce inflammation, lubricating eye drops prescribed by eye specialists can also offer comfort, eat a healthy diet comprising of salads and vegetables like carrots, drink ample amount of water, practice good hygiene such as washing hands frequently, especially after you've been in a public place which can make a difference.

This was followed by eye screening of participants in which doctor identified 2 Patient of cataract, 18 people for spectacles, and 5 person for minor operation.

The people of the area highly appreciated the initiative of the Grihini and Sightsavers and urged to have more such eye camps in future in this area.



Scusseze Story

Jan Manas Divyang SHG comprises of physically challenged members all of them are from same socio-economic background. Due to the efforts of Grihini associate a meeting was organized with the Person with disability in balodabazar in 2019. The focus of this meeting was on making the participants aware about the government scheme related to PWDs, PWDs act, the advantages of Self Help Groups (SHGs), credit linkages. The discussion helped in motivating the person with disability to set up an SHG.

Jan Manas Divyang SHG was formed in year 2019 which comprise of 10 member (2 male and 8 female) . Each member of the group deposit Rs. 25 as savings every week. The SHG also opened a bank account in Bank of India. The group also did internal lending. The group has appointed Puran Khure as President and Anita as secretary. The members of the SHG conduct weekly meetings to discuss each other's concerns, and try to resolve their problems collectively. They also discuss on rights and entitlements of PWDs, livelihood opportunities so that they can live better life.

support of Grihini associate Jan Manas divyang SHG registered their SHG under National urban livelihood mission then after they also did advocacy with Nagar Nigam for providing livelihood opportunity for their SHGs. SHG got an opportunity from social welfare department to open food stall in Hareli festival fair at Balodabazar group agreed to sell traditional food of Chhattisgarh in that fair many other SHG also took part , Jan Manas viklang SHG was also awarded Best Stall Award among self-help group on 1 August 2019.

After seeing their hard work and interest Zila Panchayt CEO & social welfare department offer PWDs SHG to run Canteen in Zila Panchayt Balodabazar. Group members also agreed to open canteen. Group also receive Rs 1,50,000 from NULM by using that amount they set up canteen. On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti on 2nd October 2019 their canteen “ Divya Khai Khajana” inaugurated by District magistrate. In which they are selling Chhattisgarh traditional food like aarisha, khurmi, thetri, chila, phra, bara, khaja etc. Now group is earning Rs 2500 to Rs 3000 per day. Each member in group is earning approximately Rs 250 -300 per day.

SHG members also share their future plan and said in order to expand canteen they want to open more outlet in other block to promote traditional food of Chhattisgarh, which will be owned by other Person with disability SHGs. Apart from this they said that they will also display all the product in their canteen which is prepared by other PWDs SHGs members of district. The members of Jan Manas Divyang SHG have now become pillars for growth and sustainability for the rest of their family members. SHG member now developed a better understanding on a wide range of issues which has brought about a positive change in their thinking and behaviour. They have become stronger both socially as well as economically. Now the PWDs of the community have also been motivated to form SHGs and start livelihood activity to live independent life.
