SHGs members training on Value Addition and Supply Chain Management

Venue: Mahila Sablikaran Kendra Kuthroud,

A two day training on value addition and supply chain was organized by Grihini at Mahila Sablikaran Kendra kuthroud with support of Sightsavers for Person with disability (PWDs) Self Help Groups (SHG) who are engaged in making phenyl and detergent powder. Main objective of this training is to aware SHGs members about how they can make quality product at less cost.

In this training from balodabazar 9 PWDs SHGs took part. In which Total 25 (Male 17, Women 8) PWDs SHGs member were present. Session start with welcoming of Resource person Mr. Rex Mehta, CEO, GPR Strategies and Solutions and Mrs Gayatri Singh after that participants one by one introduce themselves. Then Resource person said that in order to start any enterprise one must collect information related to market, raw material, customer need, competitor etc it will help them to sustain business in long run. Then after resource person asked PWDs participates what are the ingredients they use to make detergent powder and in what ratio. Resource person discuss on business plan so that SHGs members able to know about investment and expenditure. Then after resource person said that there are many expense incurred while

making detergent powder such as transportation cost, raw material, labour cost, equipment, packaging, rent, electricity cost. SHGs member share what problem they face while selling detergent powder. In addition to this resource person said that in market there are different range of detergent powder available in different quality. And suggest that in order to compete with market they have to make product which is quite similar to other competitor which are holding more no of customer. In next session both resource person suggest SHGs members to procure quality raw material in bulk so that they can minimize cost and also demonstrate PWDs how to measure quality of raw material and mention what are the things they need to keep in mind while measuring quality of Raw material. Resource person also suggest that in order to attract more customer they can also add different fragrances in detergent powder. Photos can tell the story for you- take high resolution images to support your event. Of people posing looking at the camera and in natural situations- dignitaries on dais with banner in the background; lamp lightening ceremony; ribbon cutting; group of participants; participants posing with ICT devices etc. Next day session start in which resource person ask PWDs to share what ingredient they are using for making and what is the use of phenyl. Then one by one SHGs members share what ingredient they are using and in what ratio in addition to this resource person said that in order to make their product more attract customer they can use fragrance such as lemon, , Rose, Floral, etc. Resource person then discuss on business plan of Phenyl and aware SHGs members about investment and expenditure. After that trainer demonstrate how to identify good quality of raw material for making phenyl which can easily compete in market in addition to this resource person suggest how SHG members can do cost cutting without compromising quality of Phenyl.

At last PWDs SHG member share what they have learnt during 2 day training. This was followed by thanks giving to participants as well as resource person.
