SHG Strengthening Training Program

Date: 11.09.2017 to 14.09.2017

Venue: Mahila Sablikarn Kuthroud

No of participants: Male 57 Female 33 Total 90

A three day SHG strengthening training programme is organized for newly formed SHGs all over the block of Balodabazar district Bhatapara, Simga, Palari, Balodabazar. In which training is given to ninety participants in three batches.

Training starts with welcoming of participants and they also visited GRIHINI office in which Mr Praveen and Mr. Puspendra gave a brief detail about Grihini and Sightsavers program "CG social inclusion program" in which they discuss about the objective of this program.

After that session starts with introduction of participants in Mahila Sablikaran Kendra, Kuthroud followed by a prayer song. Then a video clip of Grihini is shown to participants and Mr Tomesh Verma and Ishwar Prasad highlight important points from that video clip.

In the next session Mr Tunnen DPO leader and Ms Sona discuss about PWDs related government schemes how they can avail benefit, problems faced at village level and he also explains what strategies to adopt to solve that problem. Then both trainers highlight some important rights and laws of PWDs such as

1. Mental and Health act 1987
2. Indian rehabilitation council act
3. PWDs act-1995
4. National Trust Act 1999
5. UNCRPD 2006-2007 disabled person act
6. Person with Disability Act 2016

After that both DPO leaders discuss about how to do advocacy at different levels and what strategies and methods to adopt for proper advocacy and they also mention that for advocacy they can use media with the help of this they can aware government officials what problem they are facing, After that trainer highlights the mantra of press release advocacy Mantra of press release advocacy consists of 4W (what, when, where, who) and 1H (how). Then they discuss about fundamental rights, quality of good DPO leader. Both trainers highlight how to manage their SHG what are the things which they must keep in mind in order to succeed their SHG.

In the next session both trainers Mr Surendra verma discuss about national and international days for PWDs and important days for PWDs. After that Mrs. Rupa Srivastava highlights the importance of SHG its objective and benefit and also mention that unity among members is one of the important pillars of any SHG she also gave different examples of unity among members of SHG and what they can achieve in group. This was followed by a feedback session and thanks giving to all participants.



Success story

Roshni Purena belongs to middle class family lives in Purani basti, Balodabazar. Her Father Shri Hira Ram Purena is farmer. She is having one sister and three brother. Her brother is working as a teacher and her other brother is working in employment exchange as data entry operator and her other brother is working as advocate and her sister got married. Roshini was disabled and physically weak since her birth she studied till class 8th after that she is not able to continue her further study due to disability. At that time she is only getting benefit of pension schemes and not receiving other government schemes.

She came to know about GRIHINI “CG social inclusion program” after she came to know about many PWDs government schemes and how to avail that government schemes. Her family also support her every time and they did advocacy for Motorise tricycle. She also start attaining training such as skill development which is organize by GRIHINI. With support of GRIHINI now she is working in National Urban livelihood Mission under swaksh Bharat Abhiya her job is to segregate plastic and other solid material form waste and earning Rs 5,000 and now she is living better and also support her family financially. Now she fell is self-dependent and live better dignified life. Apart from this she is also member of DPO. Every time she also motivate other PWDs to do job and live better dignified life.



Success story

A man whose name is Pechan Sahu, suffering from locomotor disability, belongs to Donadhi village, Balodabazar district. He is from a very poor family. He lives with his mother, and his father and brother live separately. He is not getting any help from his mother because his mother is too old to manage her house. In his family, there is no financial support except pension, and one acre of agriculture land, any way they spend their life. Except pension, he is not getting other schemes benefit from government.

In the year 2016, Pechan Sahu came to know about GRIHINI CG social inclusion program, and he came to know about PWDs act and government schemes related to PWDs. Then he became a member of district level DPO sangh in which he attends meetings regularly. With the support of GRIHINI staff, he did advocacy and got a motorized tricycle from the social welfare department, Balodabazar. He also participated in PWDs youth conference, in which he selected a bride for himself. With the support of GRIHINI, he got married in ULTRA TECH Rural Development centre where a mass marriage was organized. After getting married, he submitted an application for a Ration card, now he is getting every month 35 kg of ration for his family under Pradhan Mantri Ration Yojana. When his wife got pregnant and admitted in a private hospital in order to pay charges for hospital, he mortgaged his own land but he is not able to do payment of hospital. Then he shared his story with GRIHINI cluster coordinator, who suggested him to contact village health and nutrition samati, Donadhi. When he contacted the concerned department, he got Rs 9000 and his SHG also received Rs 1000 so that he can do some activities in SHG.

Now he is living with his wife, son, mother, and father. He is also an active member of PWDs SHG and he also got various training from GRIHINI.

Success Story

Being a disabled by both legs I was excluded from society but my family always support me every time said Vina Sahu. She belongs to middle class family there only eight people living in her family, her father is driver. Vina lives in Indra Colony, Balodabazar. She is having two brothers and two sister and all of them are married. Vina is elder among them. She study till class eight because her family is not financially strong and after her mother death she is not able to go away at far places for her further study because her mother use to carry her in school. Vina use to dream big and her passion to do something. She got stitching training under Skill development program and started stitching in her house in small scale and use to support her family financial.

She came to know about GRIHINI and gather information related to government schemes and Person with disability act. She is only getting pension apart from this she is not getting any other benefit from government. After gathering information she started doing advocacy for gaining government benefit. She also motivate PWDs of her locality to form SHG and she form 10 members PWDs SHG. In which members are saving Rs 100 and they also open SHG account in State Bank of India. She also attain agarbati training, paper craft which was organized by GRIHINI so that her SHG link with livelihood activity and earn their livelihood on sustainable basis. With support of GRIHINI now she is working in National Urban livelihood Mission under Swaksh Bharat Abhiya her job is to segregate plastic and other solid material form waste and earning Rs 5,000 and now living dignified life.

PWDs Problems are as follows:

1. No information is spread to all village panchayat regarding PWDs Unique Identity Card.
2. No accessible environment found in government office and banks and other public places.
3. At village level no SHG were linked with NRLM so that PWDs SHG are not getting any benefit.
4. They also submit application regarding Motorize cycle charger.
5. PWDs still facing problem in getting Motorize cycle since 1 year they are waiting.
6. Health department are not cooperating with PWDs for making rail pass.
7. PWDs are not getting benefit of bus pass benefit, conductor of bus are not accepting bus pass.
8. PWDs in Balodabazar district are not getting 10 kg Rashaan under chief minister rashaan scheme.
9. Educated PWDs are not getting job and there is no skill development program is organize for them.
10. PWDs are not getting employment card by labour department.

Due to absence of ministers application was submitted to secretary. After this DPO went for exposure visit to Mukhtangan, Naya Raipur, and ministry building seva nikataen , Cheri Kheri and banjara dham.

Ltd., Raipur where they gather information related to different type and style of bed sheet, saree, petticoat, night drees, Pillow cover etc. employee of Sumeet Synfab gave brief detail about different quality of fabrics and its price. Then they showed stitching machining which they are using for stitching they also explain method of using stitching machine for efficient and effective result. Sumeet Synfab India Pvt. Ltd. is wholesaler for retail market they use to sell cloths in bulk.
